

Five Year Plan

Over the next five years the program forecast would initially be to reduce the current waiting list and to achieve this, Colorado Service Dogs, Inc. wants,

- ◆ To place 12 dogs for year ending 2009.
- ◆ To double to 24 dogs for the year ending 2010.
- ◆ To place 50 dogs per year for the next three years to all placement categories.

Therefore, the goal of Colorado Service Dogs, Inc. is to raise necessary funds to meet the needs of the projected forecast with placing **187** Service Dogs to people in need with physical & mental disabilities. It is planned for the management of the volunteer breeding and puppy raising program to eventually produce **100** trained Service Dogs each year.

To achieve the Colorado Service Dog's five-year plan it is imperative for the following;

- ◆ Fundraising arm of the organization to form partnerships with service clubs, commercial organizations, trusts and high level corporate companies.
- ◆ Continue to create a strong public image is a priority for the organization.
- ◆ Create a breeding program with Volunteer Breeders and puppy raisers.
- ◆ Breed 1 litter of Labradoodles for future Autism Service Dogs once a year.
- ◆ Place dogs to the recipients every three to four months.
- ◆ To raise funds in accordance with the placement objectives.
- ◆ Continue to place segments of the organization to the media.
- ◆ Advance the Sponsorship programs.
- ◆ Create more corporate partnerships.
- ◆ Continue to create awareness through the pet industry, vet agencies and staff, dog boarding kennels, breeding clubs, dog training clubs/organization and state agencies.
- ◆ Create awareness and funding through major events throughout Colorado.
- ◆ Establish and excel our new Therapy Dog program "Canines For Comfort".
